Gentlemen:

I am an attorney for a man who claims he was convicted of a crime on the perjurious' testimony of corrupt U.S. drug agents. In my client's trial, American DEA agent Derek Maltz testified that he personally brought 20 kilos of heroin from Pakistan to the United States on a commercial airline. He testified that he flew Air France from Pakistan to Paris, where he embarked and then flew TWA from Paris to New York. I enclose a copy of his testimony (the truth of which is not in dispute). I also enclose a letter from Pakistan's Narcotics Control Board indicating that the flight on your airline was Flight No. 0189, leaving Karachi at 1:00 a.m. on December 4, 1990.

I am most anxious to learn if your company was ever informed that your airline was being used to transport 20 kilos of heroin or that the heroin would actually be carried into your Paris terminal before the disembarking on TWA.

I would very much appreciate a prompt reply on this matter.
